❖ Present Tense (My Little Einstein, pg. 22-25)

The present tense of a verb tells that something is happening now.

I eat the apple.

❖ Past Tense (My Little Einstein, pg. 25-26)

The past tense of a verb tells that something already happened.

I ate the apple.

❖ Future Tense (My Little Einstein, pg. 25)

The future tense of a verb tells that something will happen later.

I will eat the apple later.

❖ Pronouns

It is a word that is used to replace the noun.

my her he his their your

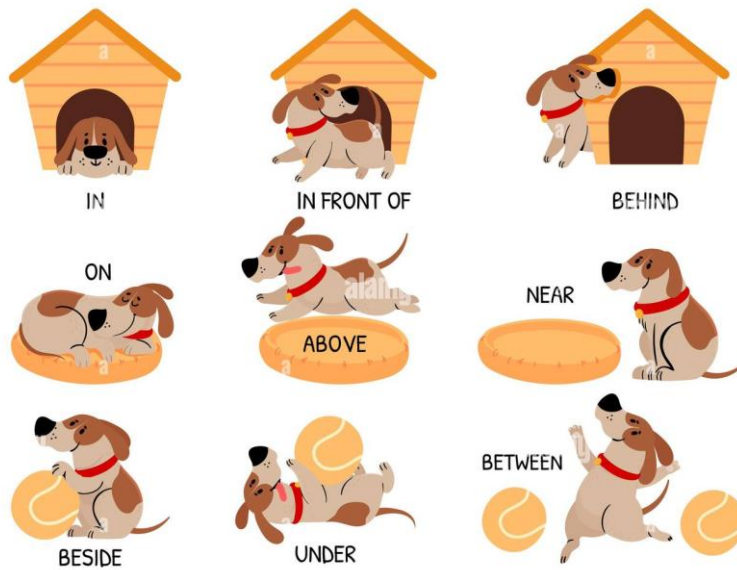
Sarah eats an apple, it is her apple.

❖ Preposition

Prepositions are the words that indicate location or relation to an object.

Prepositions are found before a noun or a pronoun.

Voorbeeld *(Example)*

Die meisie speel met haar pophuis. *(The girl plays with her doll house.)*

→ Besitlike Voornaamwoord (Pronoun)

1. Dit wys dat iets aan iemand behoort.
(It shows that something belongs to someone.)

Voorbeeld *(Example)*

Dit is sy bal. *(It is his ball.)*

Dit is my boek. *(It is my book.)*

Sheila koop 'n perd. Dit is haar perd. *(Sheila bought a horse. It is her horse.)*

→ Persoonlike Voornaamwoord (Personal Noun)

1. Dit staan in die plek van 'n persoon se naam. (*It stand in the place of a persons name.*)

Voorbeeld (*Example*)

Ek, hy, sy, ons, hulle, julle

- ❖ Know place value:
Place value is the value of each digit in a number. The value of each digit is shown in hundreds, tens and units. *Ones* and units represent the same thing.
Example:

170	=	1 hundred + 7 tens + 0 units
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Expanded notation / Rename (HTU)

$$147 = \underline{100} + \underline{40} + \underline{7}$$

Numerical Value of a number

$$3\underline{4}2 = \underline{40}$$

❖ Fractions on pg. 52

$$\frac{1}{2} = \text{one half}$$

$$\frac{1}{3} = \text{one third}$$

$$\frac{1}{4} = \text{one quarter}$$

$$\frac{1}{5} = \text{one fifth}$$

❖ Addition on pg. 55

Example: $75 + 23 = 98$

Method: $(70 + 20) + (5 + 3)$
 $90 + 8$
 98

❖ Subtraction on pg. 55

Example: $87 - 45 = 42$

Method: $(80 - 40) + (7 - 5)$
 $40 + 2$
 42

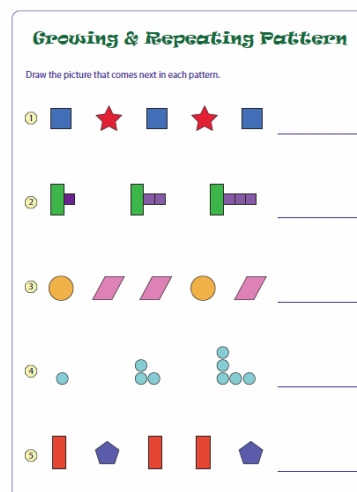

Examples of Geometric Patterns



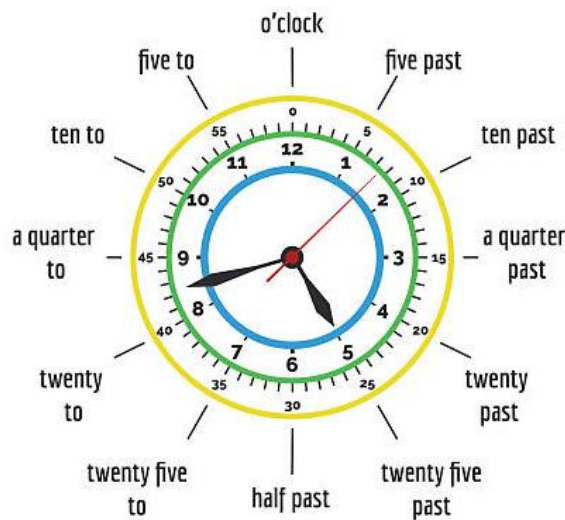

milliliter = ml

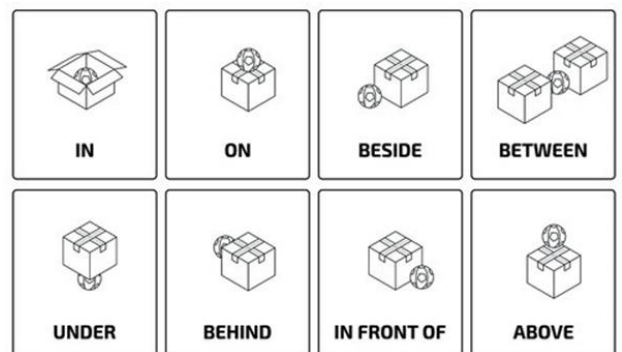
